

Animal Friends University: Dog Training Classes

Guidelines

Animal Friends is committed to a safe and respectful space for people and their dogs. To support this, visitors must agree to the following:

- Visitors are asked to respect all facilities owned and operated by Animal Friends.
- Visitors are asked to refrain from using the walking trails on Animal Friends' property.
- Visitors agree to clean up after themselves and their dogs while on Animal Friends' property.
- Visitors agree to follow all applicable dog laws.
- Recognize that the campus contains an animal shelter and public veterinary clinic.
- Recognize that any time their dog enters the property of an animal shelter/veterinary clinic there are certain risks.
- Assume the liability for such risks including but not limited to parasites and communicable diseases as well as the presence of shelter and public animals.
- No female dogs in heat are permitted to attend dog training classes.
- All dogs participating in training classes should be properly licensed, up-to-date on Rabies and DHLPP vaccinations and free of parasites. Lyme and Bordetella vaccines are highly recommended, for your dog's best protection, but not required to participate in dog training classes at Animal Friends.
- Be responsible for the actions of their dog(s) at all times and to assume all the risks of and responsibilities for accidents, damages, and personal injuries therefrom, to either guest or guest's property or dog(s) or to that of others resulting from the actions of guest's dog(s).
- Give full permission to use name and photograph in connection with this dog training class.
- Children under 18 must be accompanied by an adult and children must be closely supervised.
- In the last 14 days, if any visitors are experiencing signs or symptoms of illness, have been in contact with someone who is believed to be positive for COVID-19 or have travelled outside the area, especially where there is an uptick of cases, you must not report to class. A refund will be processed.

Release and Waiver of Liability

This agreement is between Animal Friends and _____ (visitor) for participation in dog training classes on Animal Friends campus. This agreement runs for the calendar year _____. This agreement and all collateral matters are governed by and construed in accordance with Pennsylvania law.
